
Compare and Contrast

When you compare, you tell how two things are alike.

When you contrast, you tell how they are different.

Follow these steps to compare and contrast as you read:

- Ask yourself how two people or things are the same. Look for signal words such as both, like, also, and in addition.
- Ask yourself how two people or things are different. Look for signal words such as *unlike*, *but*, *rather than*, and *however*.
