 - FELL's now receive additional ENL service in the classroom



ENL Students:

- Your child is receiving English as a New Language (ENL) services this coming 2016-2017 school year based on their scores from either the Spring 2016 NYSESLAT or Fall 2016 NYSITELL.
 - NEW: If your child scored a 3 or 4 on the English Language Arts and was Advanced, they are now considered a FELL, Former English Language Learner. Those students who were considered FELL last year did not take the NYSESLAT. The same rule applies this year.
- **Our ENL program is a push-in program**, which means the ENL teacher visits your child's classroom 1-3 periods a day. During this time, the ENL teacher works with small groups of students formed based on student's ENL levels and/or literacy needs.

- Teacher works with small groups, who are reading the same leveled texts focusing on specific reading skills/ strategies.
- Graphic Organizers/ Charts

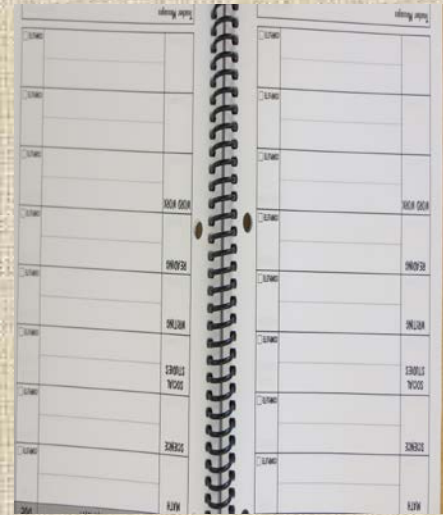
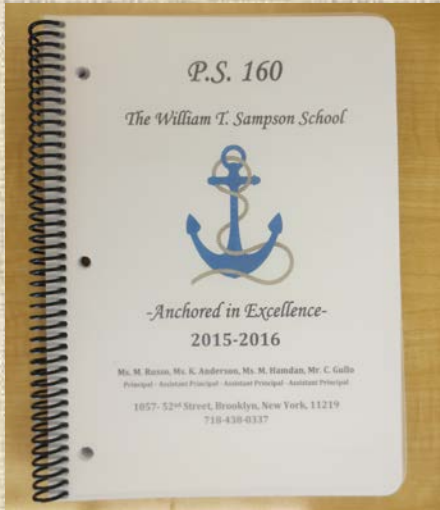
- **NYSESLAT Preparation**

- NYSESLAT is an English language test to determine students' eligibility for ENL services and proficiency levels. It has 4 parts: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing.
- Students will be given NYSESLAT Prep Workbooks and lessons will be based on students' needs to prepare them for this year's test.



ENL Parent Conferences

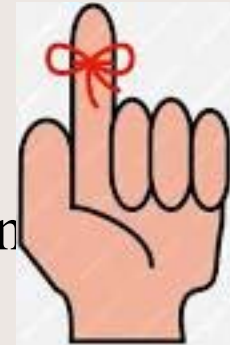
